In case you accept this offer, you **may send a demand draft of Rs.1,42,000.00 (including Rs.12,000.00 for books and reading material)** In case of company sponsored candidates please send a demand draft **Rs.4,62,000/-((including Rs.12,000.00 for books and reading material)** in favour of **“International Management Institute, New Delhi” payable at New Delhi**, towards the first installment of the programme fees. In case the said amount is not received until **March 31 2008 by 5.30 pm**, the offer will automatically stand withdrawn without any further notice.

You are advised to report to the Programme Office at 11.00 a.m on 19<sup>th</sup> June 2008 for registration and other formalities. In case you sought hostel accommodation, our office will be in touch with you after the admissions have been finalized. Please note that hostel accommodation is limited and preference is given to outstation candidates. You should note that the offer of admission does not automatically secure a hostel seat.

IMI will comply with AICTE guidelines in regard to refund of fees collected from candidates. Please refer to the public notice issued on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2008 in major English Dailies. As stated above the course commences on 19<sup>th</sup> June 2008. Once the programme starts we will not refund the fee. The candidate withdrawing after the commencement of the programme will not get any refund. For candidates withdrawing

before commencement of the programme, IMI will retain rupees 1,000 as processing fee and refund the rest.
