Research papers must be **Entirely Original**, **Not Previously Published** elsewhere or **Under Consideration**. All submissions must be double spaced with 2.5 cm margins using 12 point Times New Roman font in a single MS-Word file. The Extended abstract submission should be in a file marked Main Document-Anonymous. The submission should also be accompanied with a separate identification file, which includes the Title, Author/s (names, affiliation, e-mails and other details) details. The submission may be in the form of

- An **Extended Abstract** (350-400 words)
- A **Full Paper** with an **Abstract** (no more than 100 words) and 3-5 **Key Words**. Please note: Final paper should not exceed 3000 words including references.
